ST. GEORGE ANNUAL GREEK FESTIVAL POSTPONED TO 2021

Schenectady, NY — Due to ongoing concerns and challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Festival Planning Committee of St. George Greek Orthodox Church in Schenectady, NY has come to the decision to cancel the 2020 Annual Greek Festival which would have taken place September 11-13, 2020.

According to Brian Goodale, Parish Council President, “For 44 years the parishioners of St. George have delighted in sharing their Greek heritage, culture and religion with the capital district community. We are saddened to cancel this year’s event but due to the continued uncertainty of the COVID-19 pandemic, we feel it necessary to proceed with an abundance of caution. The safety and health of our volunteers and patrons is of utmost importance. We thank everyone for their many years of support and look forward to greeting our guests next year. Our thoughts and prayers are with everyone who has been affected by this crisis.”

The St. George Greek Festival is traditionally held the weekend after Labor Day. Next year’s dates are September 10-11-12, 2021.
