Dear Parishioners,

Holy Week and Pascha will be here very soon, and during that time, we have many services to which all are welcome to attend. I do hope that you will bring yourselves and families to worship during this most spiritual season as we journey with Christ towards his selfless death and Glorious Resurrection, when we will all cry out with joy: "Christos Anesti!" But first I do have a couple of housekeeping points to make.

I do ask that everyone please make every effort to arrive on time for church services- not only for the Holy Week services, but all throughout the year. As we are there for worship and thanksgiving to God, it is necessary to be present at the beginning of each service. To stroll in late creates an atmosphere of casual worship- something not part of our Orthodox mindset. Not only does late arrival present a loose, relaxed feel, but it disrupts the worship of the others who are already present in church. Naturally, things occur when we might arrive a bit late once or twice. This is not a problem. What is problematic is when it becomes the norm. Would one go to work late? Would one show up late for a movie or a broadway show? Probably not. God has given us everything, and He deserves that respect.

Second, we are always looking for Altar Servers. If you know of any young man who would like to serve, please contact me. The child is more than welcome to come up to the altar area with us and sit so he can observe what we do and see if it's right for him. I do not necessarily have any age requirements, because, as I have discovered over the years, some 6-year olds take their Altar duties as responsibly as do much older kids. So, if anyone wants to join our humble crew, please let me know.

I am scheduling a mandatory Altar Server meeting on Saturday, May 6th at 10AM for current and prospective Servers. The meeting will not go very long and there will be handouts to bring home and study.

Please continue to consult the bulletins, newsletters, and the website for information concerning our Holy Services and all other events at our parish.

In closing, I would like to thank all of the donors who contributed throughout our Paschal Lenten season. Your generosity and the beauty it affords is a testament of your love for the Church.







DAD LENTEN RETREAT. On Saturday, March 11, 2017, Eliana Georgelos and Olga Delorey attended the 3rd Annual Direct Archdiocesan District Lenten Retreat at the Holy Trinity Archdiocesan Cathedral in New York City. The Retreat Master was Very Rev. Dr. Nathanael Symeonides who spoke on the topic of "Humility". Following the presentation, attendees were assigned to small groups to discuss their philanthropic efforts. Each year, the DAD Executive Board selects a philanthropic effort and invites the participation of all chapters in the district. This year's cause was HOPE Project which was founded by the sisters of All Saints Greek Orthodox Monastery in Calverton, NY. This program provides housing, education, occupation, healthcare and mental health services to women who are survivors of human trafficking. DAD provided custom designed duffle bags with the goal of filling 100 bags containing personal care items and basic clothing. Our St. George Chapter purchased and donated the contents of two (2) complete duffle bags!

SOUP KITCHEN. On **Tuesday**, **February 28**, **2017** our Philoptochos prepared and served dinner for **129 persons** at the **Salvation Army Soup Kitchen**. The Soup Kitchen was sponsored by **Mike and Elaine Euripidou In Loving Memory of their Parents**. May their memory be eternal. A Trisagion Service was chanted by Father Sean. The dinner consisted of Hunter Style Chicken Stew with Potatoes, Peas and Carrots, Bread & Butter, Fruit Cup, Dessert, Juice and Coffee. 


