Congratulations to Andrew Giakoumis,

recipient of the Annual High School Graduate Award in Memory of Greg Georgelos

The Greg Georgelos award has been given to a St. George high school graduate since 2008. It is given in memory of *Theo Gregory Georgelos*, a devoted member of our church who died on May 29, 2007. Greg was an active St. George parishioner who gave of himself in many capacities for the betterment of our community. He worked tirelessly during our yearly Greek festivals, served for many years on the Parish Council in numerous capacities (acting treasurer, vice president, president and pledge committee chairman), and was an originator of our youth's involvement in the Junior Greek Olympics held for many years in Syracuse, NY. Greg was committed to the youth of not only our community, but also to the numerous students in the school district in which he worked



Outside of church, Greg was an educator who spent the majority of his career as a guidance counselor, then director of guidance and pupil personnel services in the Shenendehowa Central School District. There, he was dedicated to working with students who struggled in school due to any number of obstacles and often needed additional encouragement. Upon his death, Greg's colleagues chose to honor his memory by creating an annual "most improved" award to a graduating student who might otherwise be overlooked but who nevertheless was deserving of recognition.



Upon reflecting on how to best deal with the donations to our church in Greg's memory, his family (wife Eliana and children, Lisa and Theo) decided that an award to a St. George high school graduate would best exemplify Greg's life long devotion to students and be a wonderful way to keep his memory alive within the St. George community. Thus, the Greg Georgelos award was created. The Parish Council chooses the recipient of the award every year based on the student's involvement and devotion to our church.

Greetings from the Fellowship Group!

On June 4th, we celebrated the Great Feast of Pentecost, the commemoration of the descent of the Holy Spirit among the apostles and the full revelation of the Holy Trinity...Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The apostles received "the power from on high," and they began to preach and bear witness to Jesus as the risen Christ. This moment has traditionally been called the birthday of the one Holy Catholic and Apostolic church.

Although no Great Feasts, we commemorate three prominent feast days during the moth of June...those of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist on June 24th, the martyrdom of Saints Peter and Paul on June 29th, and the Feast of the Apostles on June 30th. During this period of time, we also observe the Fast of the Apostles which always begins on the second Monday following Pentecost (this year on June 12th) and ends on June 29th. 


